

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Landslide Incident in Brgy. Siana, Mainit, Surigao del Norte

as of 13 May 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 11 May 2024, a landslide incident due to the failure of the embankment of an old tailings storage facility of a nearby mining company located in Tubod, Surigao del Norte that resulted in the displacement of families and persons in Brgy. Siana, Mainit, Surigao del Norte.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **319 families** or **1,065 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Siana, Mainit, Surigao del Norte** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **271 families** or **887 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **six (6) evacuation centers** in **Surigao del Norte** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **48 families** or **178 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are **319 families** or **1,065 persons** displaced in **Surigao del Norte** (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **26 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Siana, Mainit, Surigao del Norte** (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱2,804,727.56** worth of **food and non-food items (FNIs)** from **DSWD** was provided to the affected families (see Annex F).

13 May 2024	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The LGU of Mainit together with the Philippine Red Cross conducted Psychological First Aid (PFA) to the displaced families and individuals in the evacuation centers.
12 May 2024	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • DSWD FO Caraga conducted an assessment to the IDPs displaced inside the evacuation centers.

13 May 2024	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • DSWD FO Caraga is in close coordination with the LGU of Mainit, Surigao del Norte for significant updates and further relief augmentation requests.
12 May 2024	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • DSWD FO Caraga attended a coordination meeting with the Municipal Social Welfare and Development Office (MSWDO) and Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction Management Office (MDRRMO) of Mainit, Office of Civil Defense (OCD) Caraga, and representatives from the Green Resource Corporation to further assess the needs of the IDPs.
