

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Oil Spill Incident in New Washington, Aklan as of 31 May 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On May 26, 2024, an oil spill occurred along the Lagatik River in New Washington, Aklan, originating from a dismantled ship at Metallica Shipyard. The spill affected riverbanks and private-owned ponds, impacting the livelihoods of fisherfolk and oyster growers in the area.

In response, the LGU of New Washington issued Executive Order No. 034, suspending fishing activities near the shipyard. This measure aimed to mitigate further damage to the environment and the livelihoods of local residents.

The LGU of New Washington in coordination with the Philippine Coast Guard (PCG) and Metallica Shipyard already conducted siphoning operations and initial results show that the spilled oil was already contained.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **119 families** or **560 persons** are affected in **two (2) barangays** in **New Washington, Aklan** (see Annex A).
