

## DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Carol-An, City of Kabankalan, Negros Occidental as of 08 May 2024, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 06 May 2024 at around 5:00 PM, an armed conflict transpired in Brgy. Carol-An, City of Kabankalan, Negros Occidental between the troops of the Philippine Army (PA) and members of the Communist Part of the Philippines-New People's Army (CPP-NPA), which led to displacement of families and individuals in the community.

Relative to the incident, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region VI, actively engaged response operation, and promptly provided relief assistance to support the immediate needs of the affected families/individuals.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **115 families** or **466 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Carol-An, City of Kabankalan, Negros Occidental** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### Inside Evacuation Center

There are **115 families** or **466 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Covered Court** in **Brgy. Carol-An, City of Kabankalan, Negros Occidental** (see Annex B).

### IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱636,185.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱533,945.00** from **DSWD** and **₱102,240.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex C).
