

## DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Armed Conflict in Peñablanca, Cagayan

as of 19 May 2024, 6AM

### I. Situation Overview

On 10 May 2024 at around 2:00 AM, an armed conflict transpired at Sitio Ebi, Brgy. Lapi, Peñablanca, Cagayan between the troops of Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP) and the members of Komiteng Rehiyon Cagayan Valley (KR-CV), which resulted to the displacement of families and individuals residing in the area.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **690 families** or **2,765 persons** are affected in **two (2) barangays** in Peñablanca, Cagayan (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **690 families** or **2,765 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives (see Annex B).

### IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱488,581.60** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex C).
