





DSWD DROMIC Report #5 on the Landslide Incident in Brgy. Siana, Mainit, Surigao del Norte as of 22 May 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On May 11, 2024, a landslide incident occurred due to the failure of an embankment at an old tailings storage facility owned by a nearby mining company in Tubod, Surigao del Norte, resulting in the displacement of families and individuals in Barangay Siana, Mainit, Surigao del Norte.

In response, the DSWD through its Field Office in Caraga Region, actively engaged in the response operation and promptly provided relief assistance to support the immediate needs of the affected families and individuals.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **337 families** or **1,148 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Siana, Mainit, Surigao del Norte** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **50 families** or **171 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **six (6) evacuation centers** in **Brgy. Siana, Mainit, Surigao del Norte** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **51 families** or **176 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are 50 families or 171 persons displaced in Brgy. Siana, Mainit, Surigao del Norte (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **28 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Siana, Mainit, Surigao del Norte** (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱3,803,701.56 worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex F).

1. Standby Funds

c. Internally Displaced Person (IDP) Protection

13 May 2024	The LGU of Mainit together with the Philippine Red Cross conducted Psychological First Aid (PFA) to the displaced families and individuals in the evacuation centers.
12 May 2024	DSWD FO Caraga conducted an assessment to the IDPs displaced inside the evacuation centers.







d. Other Activities

22 May 2024	 DSWD FO Caraga closely coordinated with the LGU of Mainit, Surigao del Norte for significant updates and further relief augmentation requests.
12 May 2024	DSWD FO Caraga attended a coordination meeting with the Municipal Social Welfare and Development Office (MSWDO) and Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction Management Office (MDRRMO) of Mainit, Office of Civil Defense (OCD) Caraga, and representatives from the Green Resource Corporation to further assess the needs of the IDPs.
