

# DSWD DROMIC Report #80 on the Effects of El Niño

## as of 25 May 2024, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

From July 2023 to April 2024, El Niño conditions prevailed in the tropical Pacific Ocean. As of May 2024, although El Niño across the tropical Pacific Ocean is weakening, its impacts, such as hotter and drier conditions, persist. Thus, the Department continues to manage the effects of El Niño including food security, water shortages and livelihood as response operation are ongoing.

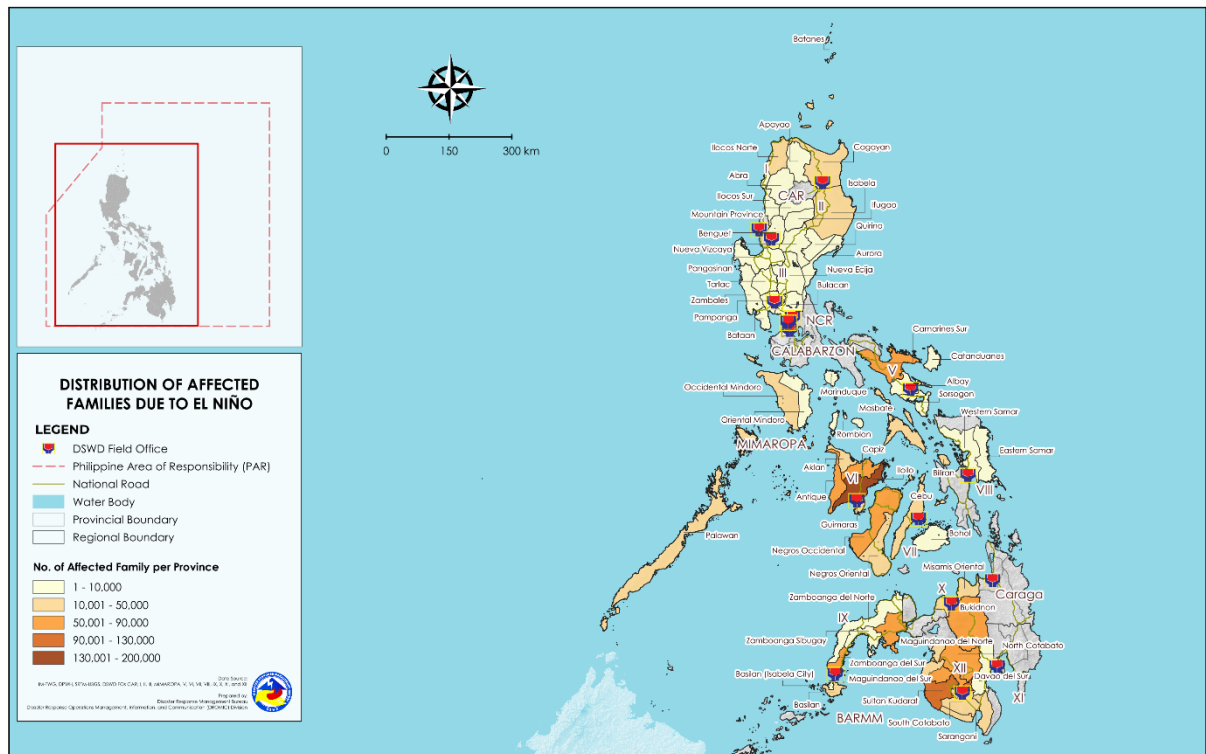
Moreover, a transition from El Niño to ENSO-neutral conditions is anticipated in June 2024, increasing the likelihood for La Niña development up to 69% for the July-August-September (JAS) 2024 period.

Given the circumstances, the PAGASA ENSO Alert and Warning System still remains at El Niño / La Niña Watch.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **1,270,433 families** or **4,860,414 persons** are affected in **6,441 barangays** in **Regions I, II, III, MIMAROPA, V, VI, VII, VIII, IX, X, XI, XII, CAR, and BARMM** (see Annex A).



### III. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱498,620,994.20** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families composed of **₱452,374,416.20** from the **DSWD**, **₱38,060,578.00** from the **Local Government Units (LGUs)**, **₱1,711,000.00** from the **Non-Government Organizations (NGOs)** and **₱6,475,000.00** from **Other Partners** (see Annex B).
