I. Situation Overview

On 07 April 2024 at around 2:40 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. 19 (Poblacion), Bacolod City, Negros Occidental. The fire was declared out at around 3:55 PM.

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱11,218.00 worth of assistance was provided to the affected family; of which, ₱6,928.00 from DSWD and ₱4,290.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex D).
