





# DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Armed Conflict in Leon, Iloilo

09 June 2024, 6PM

#### I. Situation Overview

On 02 May 2024 at around 7:30 AM, an armed conflict transpired between the 61<sup>st</sup> Infantry (Hunter) Battalion of the Philippine Army and members of the Communist Party of the Philippines – New People's Army (CPP-NPA) within the boundaries of Brgy. Bucari and Brgy. Cawilihan in Leon, Iloilo that also affected the neighboring Brgy. Cagay.

In response, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region VI, promptly provided relief assistance to support the immediate needs of the affected families and individuals.

A total of 185 families or 926 persons are affected in three (3) barangays in Leon, Iloilo (see Annex A).

#### **Outside Evacuation Center**

One (1) family or seven (7) persons temporarily stayed with their relatives (see Annex B).

#### IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P123,025.00** worth of assistance was provided by the **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex C).
