

DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Armed Conflict in Peñablanca, Cagayan

16 June 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 10 May 2024 at around 2:00 AM, an armed conflict transpired at Sitio Ebi, Brgy. Lapi, Peñablanca, Cagayan between the troops of Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP) and the members of Komiteng Rehiyon Cagayan Valley (KR-CV), which led to the displacement of families and individuals in the community.

In response, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region II, provided relief and financial assistance to support the immediate needs of those affected.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **920 families** or **3,685 persons** were affected in **two (2) barangays** in **Peñablanca, Cagayan** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **920 families** or **3,685 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱5,274,851.30** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families from the **DSWD** (see Annex C).
