

# DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 18 (Poblacion), Bacolod City, Negros Occidental

26 May 2024, 6AM

## I. Situation Overview

On 13 April 2024 at around 10:30 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. 18 (Poblacion), Bacolod City, Negros Occidental. The fire was declared out at around 1:15 PM.

A total of **47 families** or **116 persons** were affected in **Brgy. 18 (Poblacion), Bacolod City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex A).

## III. Status of Displaced Population

### Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **47 families** or **116 persons** sought temporary shelter in **Brgy. Hall of Brgy. 18 (Poblacion), Bacolod City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex B).

## IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **26 houses** were damaged; of which, **19** are **totally damaged** and **seven (7)** are **partially damaged** in of **Brgy. 18 (Poblacion), Bacolod City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex E).

## V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱977,246.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱325,616** from **DSWD** and **₱651,630.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex F).
