### **Situation Overview** Ι.

On 30 April 2024 at around 3:58 PM, a fire incident occurred at Zone 2 New Site, Brgy. Ingore, La Paz, Iloilo City. The fire was declared out at around 4:26 PM.

A total of 15 families or 38 persons are affected in Brgy. Ingore, La Paz, Iloilo City (see Annex A).

#### Ш. **Status of Displaced Population**

a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of 4 persons sought temporary shelter at the La Paz Elementary School in Brgy. Ingore, La Paz, Iloilo City (see Annex B)

- b. Outside Evacuation Center A total of **11 families** or **34 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives and/or friends (see Annex D).
- c. Total Displaced Population A total of 15 families or 38 persons were displaced in Brgy. Ingore, La Paz, Iloilo City (see Annex E).

#### IV. **Damaged Houses**

A total of **11** houses were damaged; of which, nine (9) are totally damaged and two (2) are partially damaged in Brgy. Ingore, La Paz, Iloilo City (see Annex F).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱94.344.00 worth of assistance from **DSWD** was provided to the affected families (see Annex G).
