

# DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Mangga, Candaba, Pampanga

26 February 2025, 6AM

# I. Situation Overview

On 02 May 2024 at around 12:09 PM, a fire incident occurred at Sitio Dos, Brgy. Mangga, Candaba, Pampanga.

# II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **12 families** or **46 persons** were affected in **Brgy. Mangga, Candaba, Pampanga** (see Annex A).

# III. Status of Displaced Population

- a. Inside Evacuation Center
  A total of four (4) families or 21 persons sought temporary shelter at the Old
  Brgy. Hall in Brgy. Mangga, Candaba, Pampanga (see Annex B).
- b. Outside Evacuation Center
  A total of eight (8) families or 25 persons temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex D).
- c. Total Displaced Population
  A total of 12 families or 46 persons were displaced in Brgy. Mangga, Candaba,
  Pampanga (see Annex E).

# IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **12 houses** were damaged; of which, **eight (8)** are **totally damaged** and **four (4)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Mangga, Candaba, Pampanga** (see Annex F).

# V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱197,017.36 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, ₱91,017.36 from DSWD and ₱106,000.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex G).
