

DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Sambag II, Cebu City

30 January 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 08 April 2024 at around 4:16 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Sambag II, Cebu City. The fire was declared out at around 10:16 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **274 families** or **738 persons** were affected in **Brgy. Sambag II, Cebu City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **56 families** or **129 persons** sought temporary shelter at the **City Central Night High School** in **Brgy. Sambag II, Cebu City** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **218 families** or **609 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex E).

c. Total Displaced Population

A total of **274 families** or **738 persons** were displaced in **Brgy. Sambag II, Cebu City** (see Annex F).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **91 houses** were damaged; of which, **82** are **totally damaged** and **nine (9)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Sambag II, Cebu City** (see Annex G).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱12,098,570.10** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱5,029,385.10** from **DSWD** and **₱7,069,185.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex H).
