

# DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Sambag II, Cebu City

30 January 2025, 6AM

## I. Situation Overview

On 08 April 2024 at around 4:16 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Sambag II, Cebu City. The fire was declared out at around 10:16 PM.

# II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **274 families** or **738 persons** were affected in **Brgy. Sambag II, Cebu City** (see Annex A).

# **III.** Status of Displaced Population

- a. Inside Evacuation Center
   A total of 56 families or 129 persons sought temporary shelter at the City Central
   Night High School in Brgy. Sambag II, Cebu City (see Annex B).
- b. Outside Evacuation Center
   A total of 218 families or 609 persons temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex E).
- c. Total Displaced Population
   A total of 274 families or 738 persons were displaced in Brgy. Sambag II, Cebu City (see Annex F).

# IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **91 houses** were damaged; of which, **82** are **totally damaged** and **nine (9)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Sambag II, Cebu City** (see Annex G).

# V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱12,098,570.10 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, ₱5,029,385.10 000,000.00 from DSWD and ₱7,069,185.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex H).
