

DSWD DROMIC #1 on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Maling, Balbalan, Kalinga as of 13 June 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 07 June 2024 at around 6:00 AM, an armed conflict transpired in Brgy. Maling, Balbalan, Kalinga between the 98th Infantry Battalion (IB) of the Philippine Army (PA) and unidentified members of the Communist Terrorist Group (CTG) which led to the displacement of the affected families and individuals in the area. According to reports, the said barangay is still on heightened alert which also affects the primary livelihood of the nearby farmers and residents.

A total of **two (2) families** or **six (6) persons** are affected in **Brgy. Maling, Balbalan, Kalinga** (see Annex A).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱8,656.48** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex C).
