

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Armed Conflict in Alfonso Castañeda, Nueva Vizcaya as of 22 June 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 20 June 2024 at around 12:30 AM, an armed conflict transpired between the troops of the Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP) and members of the New People’s Army at Sitio Marikit, Brgy. Abuyo, Alfonso Castañeda, Nueva Vizcaya. The armed encounter also affected a nearby barangay and resulted in the displacement of families and individuals in the area.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **36 families** or **130 persons** are affected in **two (2) barangays** in **Alfonso Castañeda, Nueva Vizcaya** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **10 families** or **39 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **two (2) evacuation centers** in **Alfonso Castañeda, Nueva Vizcaya** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **22 families** or **78 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are **32 families** or **117 persons** displaced in **Alfonso Castañeda, Nueva Vizcaya** (see Annex D).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱6,236.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱2,996.00** from **DSWD** and **₱3,240.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex E).
