





DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Laconon, T'boli, South Cotabato

as of 09 June 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 08 June 2024 at around 2:00 AM, an armed conflict transpired at Sitio Seben, Brgy. Laconon, T'boli, South Cotabato between the troops of Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP) and members unidentified armed groups.

A total of **567 families** or **2,835 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Laconon**, **T'boli**, **South Cotabato** (see Annex A).
