

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy, 125, Tondo, Manila City as of 04 June 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 01 June 2024 at around 1:00PM, a fire incident occurred at Malaya St., Brgy. 125, Balut, Tondo, Manila City. The fire was declared out at around 4PM.

A total of **65 families** or **220 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 125, Tondo, Manila City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are **65 families** or **220 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **21 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. 125, Tondo, Manila City** (see Annex C).
