#### I. Situation Overview

On 01 June 2024 at around 1:00PM, a fire incident occurred at Malaya St., Brgy. 125, Balut, Tondo, Manila City. The fire was declared out at around 4PM.

A total of **65 families** or **220 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 125**, **Tondo**, **Manila City** (see Annex A).
