

# DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 10 (Poblacion), Bacolod City, Negros Occidental

as of 27 June 2024, 6PM

## I. Situation Overview

On 26 June 2024 at around 12:30 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. 10 (Poblacion), Bacolod City, Negros Occidental. The fire was declared out at around 2:55 AM.

## II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **31 families** or **108 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 10 (Poblacion), Bacolod City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex A).

## III. Status of Displaced Population

### Inside Evacuation Center

There are **31 families** or **108 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Brgy. Hall** in **Brgy. 10 (Poblacion), Bacolod City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex B).

## IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **18 houses** were damaged; of which, **15** are **totally damaged** and **three (3)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. 10 (Poblacion), Bacolod City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex E).

## V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱284,607.28** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex F).
