

# DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 234, Tondo, Manila City

as of 26 June 2024, 6PM

## I. Situation Overview

On 26 June 2024 at around 9:05 PM, a fire incident occurred at Antonio Rivera St., Brgy. 234, Tondo, Manila City. The fire was declared out at around 1:30 AM.

A total of **74 families** or **278 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 234, Tondo, Manila City** (see Annex A).

## III. Status of Displaced Population

### Inside Evacuation Center

There are **74 families** or **278 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **Brgy. 234 Covered Court** in **Brgy. 234, Tondo, Manila City** (see Annex B).

## IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **27 houses** were damaged; of which, **26** are **totally damaged** and **one (1)** is **partially damaged** in **Brgy. 234, Tondo, Manila City** (see Annex C).
