I. Situation Overview

On 25 May 2024 at around 11:17 PM, a fire incident occurred at Block 32 Extension and Block 6, Brgy. Addition Hills, Mandaluyong City. The fire was declared out at around 12:02 PM.

A total of **41 families** or **160 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Addition Hills, Mandaluyong City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **41 families** or **160 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **Brgy. Addition Hills, Mandaluyong City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **14 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Addition Hills, Mandaluyong City** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱244,125.38** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
