

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Anahawan, Bato, Leyte as of 04 June 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 17 May 2024 at around 9:15 AM, a fire incident occurred at Sitio Albanga, Brgy. Anahawan, Bato, Leyte. The fire was declared out at around 9:30 AM.

One (1) family or **four (4) persons** are affected in **Brgy. Anahawan, Bato, Leyte** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or **four (4) persons** are temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Anahawan, Bato, Leyte** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱10,000.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
