# I. Situation Overview

On 01 June 2024 at around 8:00 PM, a fire incident occurred at KM 3, Marcos Highway, Brgy. Bakakeng Central, Baguio City. The fire was declared out at around 10:00 PM.

### **Inside Evacuation Center**

There are two (2) families or six (6) persons currently taking temporary shelter at the Multi-purpose Hall in Brgy. Bakakeng Central, Baguio City (see Annex B).

# IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **four (4) houses** were damaged; of which, **one (1)** is **totally damaged** and **three (3)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Bakakeng Central, Baguio City** (see Annex E).

# V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱56,304.80** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex F).
