

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Bakakeng Central, Baguio City as of 11 June 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 01 June 2024 at around 8:00 PM, a fire incident occurred at KM 3, Marcos Highway, Brgy. Bakakeng Central, Baguio City. The fire was declared out at around 10:00 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **five (5) families** or **11 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Bakakeng Central, Baguio City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **two (2) families** or **six (6) persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Multi-purpose Hall** in **Brgy. Bakakeng Central, Baguio City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **four (4) houses** were damaged; of which, **one (1)** is **totally damaged** and **three (3)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Bakakeng Central, Baguio City** (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱56,304.80** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex F).
