I. Situation Overview

On 31 May 2024 at around 3:32 PM, a fire incident occurred at Boholano Drive, Brgy. Camino Nuevo, Zamboanga City.

A total of 15 families or 71 persons are affected in Brgy. Camino Nuevo, Zamboanga City (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are 15 families or 71 persons currently taking temporary shelter in a covered court in Brgy. Camino Nuevo, Zamboanga City (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 15 houses were damaged; of which, 13 are totally damaged and two (2) are partially damaged in Brgy. Camino Nuevo, Zamboanga City (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P16,620.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
