I. Situation Overview

On 19 June 2024 at around 1:50 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Dolho, Bato, Leyte.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **33 families** or **133 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Dolho**, **Bato**, **Leyte** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are **33 families** or **133 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 31 houses were damaged; of which, 27 are totally damaged and four (4) are partially damaged in Brgy. Dolho, Bato, Leyte (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱316,848.10 worth of assistance from DSWD was provided to the affected families
