



DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Inawasan, Pamplona, Negros Oriental

as of 02 June 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 16 March 2024 at around 10:30 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Inawasan, Pamplona, Negros Oriental. The fire was declared out at around 6:11 AM.

Relative to the incident, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region VII, promptly provided relief assistance to support the immediate needs of the affected family.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

One (1) family or four (4) persons are affected in Brgy. Inawasan, Pamplona, Negros Oriental (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are **one (1) family** or **four (4) persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was totally damaged in Brgy. Inawasan, Pampiona, Negros Oriental (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱7,746.00 worth of assistance was provided by the DSWD to the affected family (see Annex D).

- 179,986 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 100,608 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 79,378 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 45,115 FFPs available at DSWD FO VII.
- ₱311.4 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO VII warehouses.
