

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Lapasan, Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental

as of 02 June 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 31 May 2024 at around 10:44 AM, a fire incident occurred at San Lazaro, Brgy. Lapasan, Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental. The fire was declared out at around 4:36 AM the next day. The incident has led to displacement of families and individuals in the community, wherein 43 houses were engulfed by the fire.

In response, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region X swiftly coordinated with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Cagayan de Oro City to provide immediate assistance. This included setting up a community kitchen to provide hot meals and facilitating the LGU's requests for additional relief aid.

Validation and assessment efforts are ongoing to determine the exact number of displaced families and individuals currently housed in evacuation centers, with updates to be provided in the next reporting schedule.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **78 families** or **252 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Lapasan, Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental** (see Annex A).

III. Damaged Houses

A total of **43 houses** were damaged; of which, **40** are **totally damaged** and **three (3)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Lapasan, Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental** (see Annex B).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱75,250.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex C).
