

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Mahayahay, Sogod, Southern Leyte as of 28 June 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 10 June 2024 at around 11:00 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Mahayahay, Sogod, Southern Leyte. The fire was declared out at around 12:00 in the afternoon.
