I. Situation Overview

On 13 May 2024 at around 11:00 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Manlawaan, Tabango, Leyte.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of three (3) families or eight (8) persons are affected in Brgy. Manlawaan, Tabango, Leyte (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are three (3) families or eight (8) persons temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

Three (3) houses were totally damaged in Brgy. Manlawaan, Tabango, Leyte (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P24,678.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families by **DSWD** (see Annex D).
