





DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Martilo, La Libertad, Negros Oriental

as of 02 June 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 02 March 2024 at around 10:00 AM, a fire incident occurred in Sitio Cogon Domen, Brgy. Martilo, La Libertad, Negros Oriental. The fire was declared out at around 10:44 AM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

One (1) family or seven (7) persons are affected in Brgy. Martilo, La Libertad, Negros Oriental (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or seven (7) persons temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was totally damaged and in Brgy. Martilo, La Libertad, Negros Oriental (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱34,158.50 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, ₱6,158.50 from DSWD and ₱28,000.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex D).

- ₱311.43 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO VI warehouses.
