

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Old Balara, Quezon City as of 01 June 2024, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 29 May 2024 at around 7:10 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Old Balara, Quezon City. The fire was declared out at around 7:50 PM.

A total of **25 families** or **80 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Old Balara, Quezon City** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **25 families** or **80 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **Feria Covered Court** in **Brgy. Old Balara, Quezon City** (see Annex B).

#### b. Total Displaced Population

There are **25 families** or **80 persons** displaced in **Brgy. Old Balara, Quezon City** (see Annex C).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **three (3) houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Old Balara, Quezon City** (see Annex D).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱20,448.90** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex E).
