I. Situation Overview

On 29 May 2024 at around 7:10 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Old Balara, Quezon City. The fire was declared out at around 7:50 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **25 families** or **80 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Old Balara**, **Quezon City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are 25 families or 80 persons currently taking temporary shelter in Feria Covered Court in Brgy. Old Balara, Quezon City (see Annex B).

b. Total Displaced Population

There are **25 families** or **80 persons** displaced in **Brgy. Old Balara**, **Quezon City** (see Annex C).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of three (3) houses were totally damaged in Brgy. Old Balara, Quezon City (see Annex D).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P20,448.90** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex E).
