I. Situation Overview

On 06 June 2024 at around 5:00 PM, a fire incident occurred at Sitio Bagong Barrio Sagur, Brgy. Sabangan, Binmaley, Pangasinan.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

One (1) family or **five (5) persons** are affected in **Brgy. Sabangan, Binmaley, Pangasinan** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are **one (1) family** or **five (5) persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **one (1) house** was **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Sabangan, Binmaley, Pangasinan** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱21,867.80** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱11,867.80** from **DSWD** and **₱10,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
