as of 21 June 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 18 June 2024 at around 8:00 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Sta. Agueda, Pamplona, Negros Oriental. The fire was declared out at around 9:00 AM.

One (1) family or three (3) persons are temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was totally damaged in Brgy. Sta. Agueda, Pamplona, Negros Oriental (see Annex C).
