

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Flooding Incident in Brgy. San Roque, Zamboanga City

as of 28 June 2024, 6AM

### I. Situation Overview

Issued on 26 June 2024 at 4:00 PM, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at 325 km East of Virac, Catanduanes (13.5°N, 127.2°E). It is embedded along the Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) affecting Southern Luzon, Visayas, and Mindanao.

On 26 June 2024 at around 7:00 PM, a flooding incident was reported in Brgy. San Roque, Zamboanga City, due to continuous heavy rainfall brought by the LPA and ITCZ.

A total of **350 families** or **385 persons** are affected in **Brgy. San Roque, Zamboanga City** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### Inside Evacuation Center

There are **350 families** or **385 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Talungon Evacuation Center** in **Brgy. San Roque, Zamboanga City** (see Annex B).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **10 houses** were **partially damaged** in **Brgy. San Roque, Zamboanga City** (see Annex C).
