

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Flooding Incident in Roseller Lim, Zamboanga Sibugay

as of 18 June 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 14 June 2024 at around 7:00 AM to 9:00 AM, the flooding was caused by heavy rains brought about by the presence of Southwest Monsoon affecting the western part of Mindanao Region.

A total of **147 families** or **735 persons** are affected in **Roseller Lim, Zamboanga Sibugay** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are **147 families** or **735 persons** returned to their homes immediately after the flood waters subsided (see Annex B).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱80,334.03** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex C).
