





DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Strong Wind Incident in Brgy. Lumbia, Pagadian City, Zamboanga del Sur

as of 06 June 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 05 June 2024 at around 1:20 AM, a strong wind incident occurred in Brgy. Lumbia, Pagadian City, Zamboanga del Sur causing damages to houses.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 11 families or 45 persons are affected in Brgy. Lumbia, Pagadian City, Zamboanga del Sur (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are **11 families** or **45 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of seven (7) houses were damaged; of which, six (6) are totally damaged and one (1) is partially damaged in Brgy. Lumbia, Pagadian City, Zamboanga del Sur (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P46,531.87** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
