

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Tornado Incident in Brgy. Taloy, Malasiqui, Pangasinan

as of 03 June 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 17 May 2024 at around 4:00 PM, a tornado was experienced in Brgy. Taloy, Malasiqui, Pangasinan.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

One (1) family or **six (6) persons** are affected in **Brgy. Taloy, Malasiqui, Pangasinan** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or **six (6) persons** are temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Taloy, Malasiqui, Pangasinan** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱13,516.30** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱7,916.30** from **DSWD** and **₱5,600.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
