





DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Tornado Incident in Brgy. Taloy, Malasiqui, Pangasinan

as of 03 June 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 17 May 2024 at around 4:00 PM, a tornado was experienced in Brgy. Taloy, Malasiqui, Pangasinan.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

One (1) family or six (6) persons are affected in Brgy. Taloy, Malasiqui, Pangasinan (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or six (6) persons are temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was totally damaged in Brgy. Taloy, Malasiqui, Pangasinan (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}13,516.30\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, \$\mathbb{P}7,916.30\$ from DSWD and \$\mathbb{P}5,600.00\$ from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex D).
