



DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Tornado Incident in Tapaz, Capiz

as of 14 June 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 04 June 2024 at around 2:00 PM, several barangays in the municipality of Tapaz, Capiz experienced a tornado incident that resulted in damages to properties.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **93 families** or **481 persons** are affected in **five (5) barangays** in **Tapaz**, **Capiz** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are **five (5) families** or **25 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **79 houses** were damaged; of which, **five (5)** are **totally damaged** and **74** are **partially damaged** in **Tapaz**, **Capiz** (see Annex C).
