





DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 13, Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental

as of 12 June 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 03 June 2024 at around 7:31 PM, a fire incident occurred at Burgos-Montalban St., Brgy. 13, Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental. The fire was declared out at around 9:28 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 32 families or 84 persons are affected in Brgy. 13 Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are 22 families or 54 persons currently taking temporary shelter on three (3) evacuation centers in Brgy. 13, Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 13 houses were damaged; of which, 12 are totally damaged and one (1) is partially damaged in Brgy. 13, Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱36,000.00 worth of assistance was provided by the Local Government Unit (LGU) to the affected families (see Annex D).
