





DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Dolho, Bato, Leyte

as of 28 June 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 19 June 2024 at around 1:50 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Dolho, Bato, Leyte.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **37 families** or **143 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Dolho**, **Bato**, **Leyte** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are **37 families** or **143 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **32 houses** were damaged; of which, **28** are **totally damaged** and **four (4)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Dolho, Bato, Leyte** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱316,848.10 worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
