



# DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Rivera, San Juan City

as of 07 June 2024, 6AM

## I. Situation Overview

On 31 May 2024 at around 8:10 PM, a fire incident occurred at Olazo Street, Brgy. Rivera, San Juan City. The fire was declared out at around 09:00 PM.

## **II.** Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **106 families** or **374 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Rivera, San Juan City** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

### a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **51 families** or **195 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **two (2) evacuation centers** in **Brgy. Rivera, San Juan City** (see Annex B).

#### b. Outside Evacuation Center There are 55 families or 179 persons temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

#### c. Total Displaced Population There are 106 families or 374 persons displaced in Brgy. Rivera, San Juan City (see Annex D).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **106 houses** were damaged; of which, **83** are **totally damaged** and **23** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Rivera, San Juan City** (see Annex E).

## V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱81,113.97** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex F).
