## **DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Rivera, San Juan City**

as of 07 June 2024, 6AM

### **I. Situation Overview**

On 31 May 2024 at around 8:10 PM, a fire incident occurred at Olazo Street, Brgy. Rivera, San Juan City. The fire was declared out at around 09:00 PM.

### **II. Status of Affected Areas and Population**

A total of **106 families** or **374 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Rivera, San Juan City** (see Annex A).

### **III. Status of Displaced Population**

#### **a. Inside Evacuation Center**

There are **51 families** or **195 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **two (2) evacuation centers** in **Brgy. Rivera, San Juan City** (see Annex B).

#### **b. Outside Evacuation Center**

There are **55 families** or **179 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

#### **c. Total Displaced Population**

There are **106 families** or **374 persons** displaced in **Brgy. Rivera, San Juan City** (see Annex D).

### **IV. Damaged Houses**

A total of **106 houses** were damaged; of which, **83** are **totally damaged** and **23** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Rivera, San Juan City** (see Annex E).

### **V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided**

A total of **₱81,113.97** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex F).
