

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Tornado Incident in Brgy. Macatcatud, Magsingal, Ilocos Sur as of 03 July 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 26 June 2024 at around 1:30 PM, a tornado was experienced in Brgy. Macatcatud, Magsingal, Ilocos Sur.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

One (1) family or **six (6) persons** are affected in **Brgy. Macatcatud, Magsingal, Ilocos Sur** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or **six (6) persons** sought temporary shelter at the **Macatcatud Evacuation Center** in **Magsingal, Ilocos Sur** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Macatcatud, Magsingal, Ilocos Sur** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱13,761.28** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱8,761.28** from **DSWD** and **₱5,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
