





DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Tornado Incident in Tapaz, Capiz

as of 04 July 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 04 June 2024 at around 2:00 PM, several barangays in the municipality of Tapaz, Capiz experienced a tornado incident that resulted in damages to properties.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 109 families or 566 persons are affected in seven (7) barangays in Tapaz, Capiz (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **five (5) families** or **25 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **95 houses** were damaged; of which, **five (5)** are **totally damaged** and **90** are **partially damaged** in **Tapaz**, **Capiz** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P183,038.00** worth of assistance was provided by the **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).

1. Standby Funds
