





DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Flash Flood Incident in Lambayong, Sultan Kudarat

as of 04 July 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

Issued on 26 June 2024 at 4:00 PM, the Low-Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at 325 km East of Virac, Catanduanes (13.5°N, 127.2°E). It is embedded along the Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) affecting Southern Luzon, Visayas, and Mindanao.

On 26 June 2024 at around 11:30 PM, a flash flood incident was reported in Brgy. Caridad, Lambayong, Sultan Kudarat due to continuous heavy rainfall brought by the LPA and ITCZ.

On July 1, 2024, several barangays in Lambayong, Sultan Kudarat were also experienced flashflood due to continuous heavy rains brought by the LPA and ITCZ.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 1,140 families or 3,980 persons are affected in nine (9) barangays in Lambayong, Sultan Kudarat (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are 13 families or 65 persons currently taking temporary shelter at the Brgy. Masiag Gymnasium in Bagumbayan, Sultan Kudarat (see Annex B).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱249,165.00 worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex B).
