





# DSWD DROMIC Report #4 on the Fire Incident in City Proper, Iloilo City

as of 23 June 2024, 6AM

### I. Situation Overview

On 17 June 2024 at around 2:00 AM, a fire incident occurred at the boundary of Brgy. Tanza Bonifacio and Brgy. Rizal Estanzuela, City Proper, Iloilo City. The fire was declared out at around 4:37 AM.

## II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **88 families** or **293 persons** are affected in **City Proper, Iloilo City** (see Annex A).

## III. Status of Displaced Population

#### **Inside Evacuation Center**

There are **88 families** or **293 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **two (2) evacuation centers** in **City Proper**, **Iloilo City** (see Annex B).

## IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **50 houses** were damaged; of which, **34** are **totally damaged** and **16** are **partially damaged** in **City Proper**, **Iloilo City** (see Annex C).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱1,628,984.94 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, ₱1,272,737.44 from DSWD and ₱356,247.50 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex D).
